Madrasah Rules and Regulations

The following rules and regulations are to be observed at all times by all students of Darul Uloom:

1. Attendance. Regular attendance is mandatory. Students will have to

bring in a note or medical certificate explaining any

absences.

2. Punctuality. Please ensure that children are punctual and come at least

10 minutes before classes commence so that they can

perform ablutions and be ready for classes on time.

3. Dress. All students must have appropriate dressing. For boys:

Parents must supervise and sign homework every day.

5. Parent involvement. Parents are required to follow up the progress of their

children. Thus the education of their children will be a team effort involving the student, teacher and parent.

6. Discipline. A. All students are expected to respect and listen to
